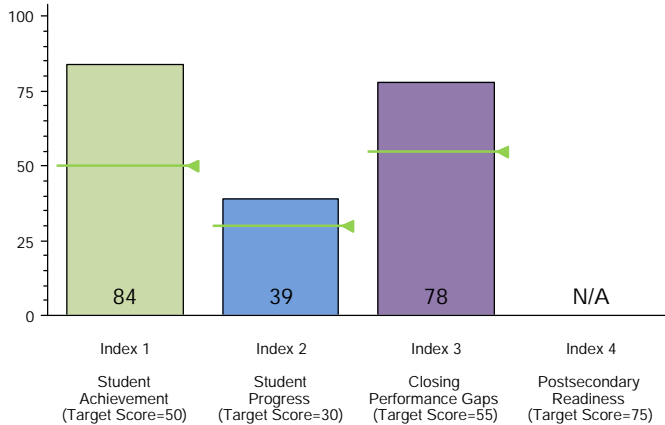


## 2013 Accountability Rating
