The Austin Independent School District takes the health and safety of our students and their families very serio such, in addition to steps to screen for the virus and prevent its spread on a campus, we are adding a voluntary K COVID19 testing program foin-personstudents and staff. This program uses Abbott Laboratories BinaxNOW tests provided by the federal government. We will only test with your consent. If you are willing to provide consent for us to administer this test oryourself (if ag 18 or older), please fill out this form. What is the test?

If you aresymptomatic or part of a group that is designated for testing, if you consent/vij/breceive a free BinaxNOW rapid test for the COVID virus Collecting a specimen for testing involves using a swab, similar toip, Q placed inside the tip of the nose. A school staff member has been trained to use this testill collect the specimen and a trained COVID test administrator will oversee the process. Test results will been available to you. The results will be sent by text message and email within 24 hours of the test. This program is entirely optional for students and staff, although we hope you choose to have the test to keep our schools as healthy & safe as possible. The tests are being offered in addition to existing safety protosols has maskearing, social/physical distancing, and frequent disinfection of surfaces.

What should I dowhen I receive my test results?

If you test positive for the virus, you wble moved to a roonaway from students and othestaff, until you canarrange transportation, if needed We ask that you stay honuentil the infection period has ended (typically, after symptoms improve and at least 10 days from the date symptoms tippear) and you areno longer contagious. If your test results are negative, the virus was not found in the specimen tested and power to work without interruption. In a small number of cases, tests sometimes produce incorrect results (called "false negatives") in people who have COVID or showing positive results (called "false positives") in people who don't have COVID9. If your test negative, a licensed medical authority, or your local health department.

## Known Symptoms

People with COVHD9 have had a wide range of symptoms reporter anging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 14 days after exposure the virus. People with these symptoms may have CO1/9D

- · Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- · Loss of tate or smell
- · Cough
- · Difficulty breathing
- · Shortness of breath
- · Fatigue
- · Headache
- · Chills
- · Sore throat
- · Congestion or runny nose
- · Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- · Significant muscle pain or ache
- · Diarrhea
- · Nausea or vomiting

This list does not include all possible symptoms.
