

Federal Standards for Collecting and Reporting Ethnicity and Race Data

In the 2009-2010 school year, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) began implementing new federal standards for the collection of ethnicity and race information. The current standards ask the individual frst to select his or her ethnicity from two options (Hispanic/ Latino or not Hispanic/Latino) and then to select one or more of five race options. For this report, parents who indicated their child's ethnicity was Hispanic/Latino are induded in the Hispanic/Latino category. Percentages for the remaining race categories refect parents who indicated their child's ethnicity was not Hispanic/ Latino.
