The rating scale was based on identified activities that support coordinated school health efforts. There were 19 required and 80 supplemental opportunities for campuses to meet or exceed the AISD CSH Program standards. All campuses submitted enough data to be rated. Brentwood Elementary School achieved 19 required and 67 supplemental items during the 2016-2017 school year.

One component of the supplemental criteria was for yearly Fitnessgram improvement. The Fitnessgram measure includes a variety of health-related physical fitness tests that assess aerobic capacity, muscular strength and endurance, flexibility, and body composition. Scores from these tests are compared
