Creative Campus Goals at Gorzycki

Each year, school leaders develop a Campus Improvement Plan (CIP). Despite there being no district requirement to do so, in 2016-2017 77% of secondary schools made CIP goals related to becoming a more Creative Campus. Gorzycki set the following goal: "Offer at least two opportunities per semester for all students to exhibit/showcase their fine arts learning in the community. PTA Reflections Project to encourage students to express themselves by submitting projects in dance, film, lit, musical composition, photography and visual arts. Literacy Initiative."

At the end of the year, school leaders reflected on their progress, as follows:

Progress: "Completely accomplished"

Challenges: "Finding a good location for performances. Our cafetorium is too small to fit music ensembles and we are left to perform in either the commons area or the gym. Conflicts in the schedule with athletics and other fine arts." **Successful Strategies:** "Working together to resolve any conflicts, and sharing students who may be performing in both departments."

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
