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Results

Coordinated School Health (CSH) Program implementation data were collected from each Austin Independent School District (AISD) campus in Spring 2017. The results indicated that Guerrero-Thompson Elementary School received a rating of **Unacceptable** for the CSH Program implementation in 2016-2017. Campus results will be reflected in the District's strategic scorecard and the House Bill 5 ratings, i.e., the School District Evaluation of Performance in Community and Student Engagement for wellness and physical education (TECS46 (C) 39.0545).

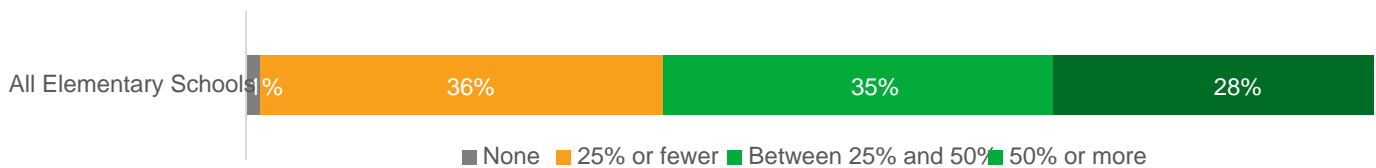

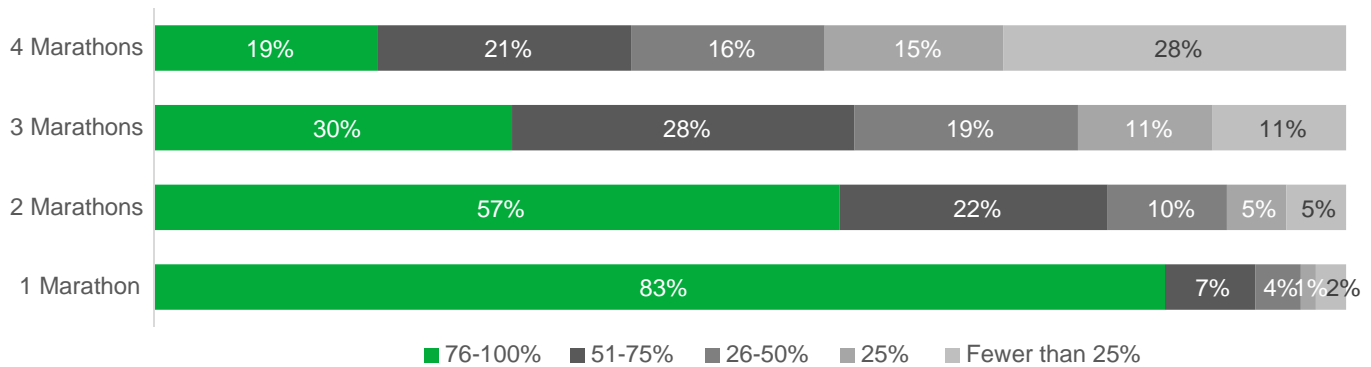
