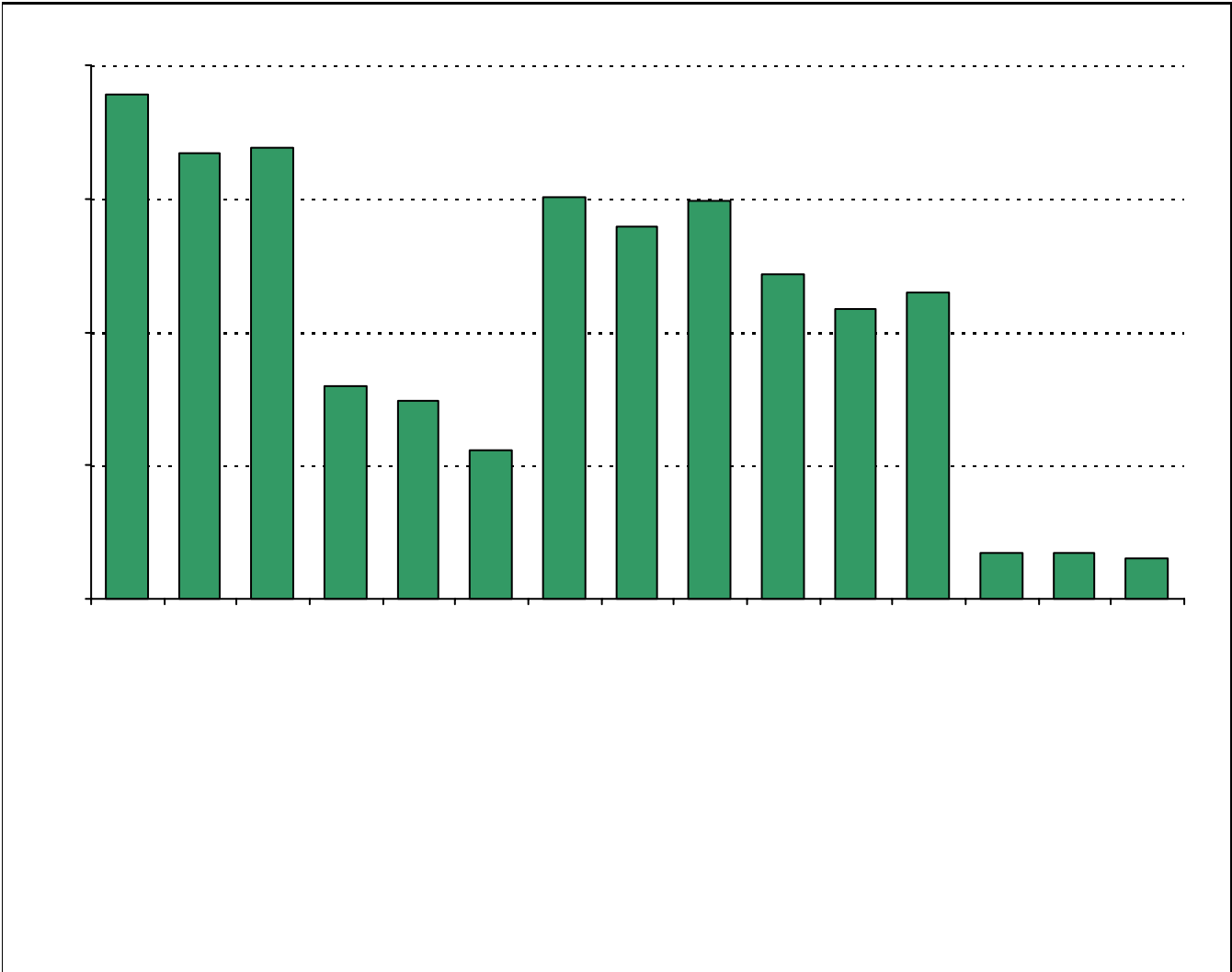
17. School staff provide me with information in my home language.*



19. Which of the following activities do you participate in at your child's school:*



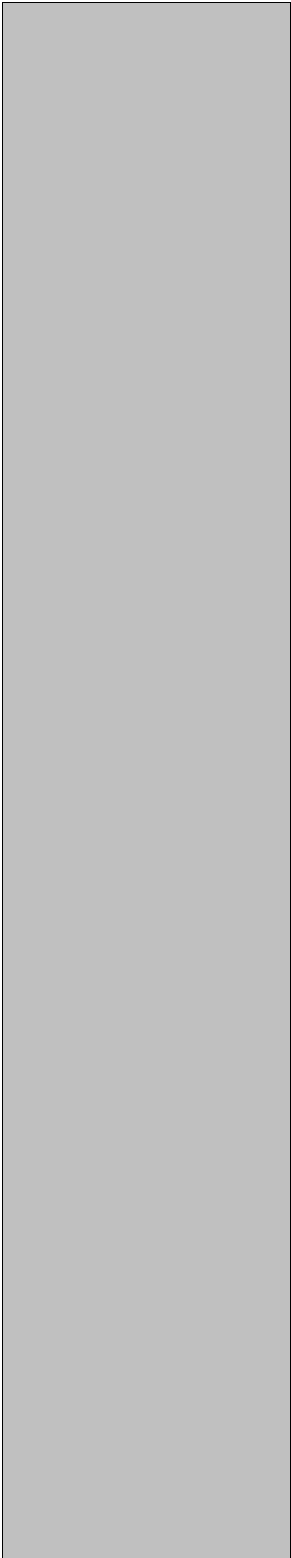
